Building Recycling Results are in...

During the month of December 2011, Balcones Resources, Inc. conducted an extensive recycling audit of both wet and recycling trash streams and they spent hours sifting through the trash from both streams. Balcones reports that they discovered a large number of items that could have been recycled ended up in wet trash and ultimately in the landfill: newspapers, office paper, cardboard, aluminum cans, and plastic drinking bottles. These items were placed in dark bags, thus confirming that the errors are not the fault of the janitorial crew. The amount of trash that Bank of America Plaza is sending to the landfill could be decreased significantly, probably 30-50%, by placing recyclable materials in the recycling bins! 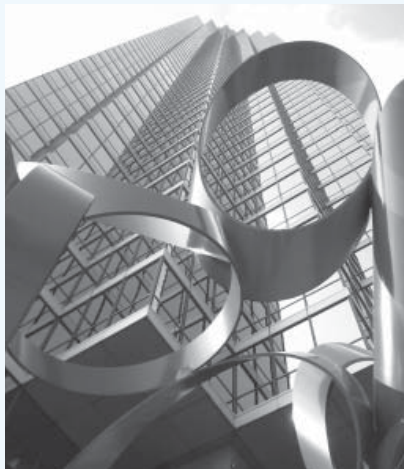

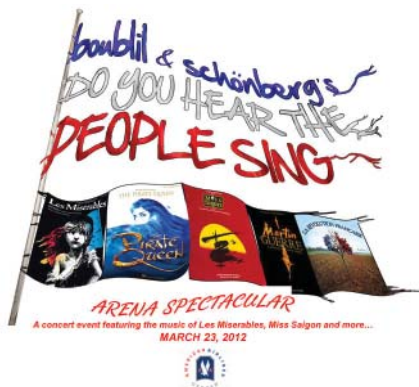

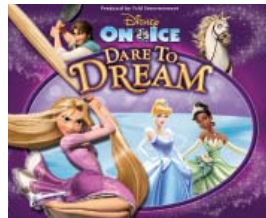

Nasher Sculpture Center

Elliott Hundley: The Bacchae; Through April 22

The Nasher Sculpture Center hosts the first touring exhibition of the distinctive "bulletin board" collages and sculptures of Los Angeles-based artist Elliott Hundley. The mythic world of ancient Greek tragedy becomes vividly contemporary as Hundley reimagines Euripides' last play, *The Bacchae*, in twelve works presented in one of the Nasher's street-level galleries.

Hundley conceives of his mixed-media collages as theatrical landscapes. First orchestrating photo shoots with friends and family members who pose as characters from the Greek drama, he then uses the resulting photographs as the underlying basis of large-scale, multi-panel compositions. From these, he builds out layers upon layers of additional images and materials, such as smaller versions of the photographs and strings of letters spelling out passages from Euripides' text. Hundley and his assistants affix most of the pictorial elements with pins—hundreds of them in a single work—creating a dizzying intensification of presence and depth. Accompanying these striking wall reliefs are large freestanding sculptures; like the reliefs, they take inspiration from passages in Euripides' play and become essential figures in Hundley's fictive world, inhabiting both the environments of the photographs and the exhibition installation.

Roz Savage: Solo Across the Ocean; February 21, Winspear Opera House

What's it like to be a million oar strokes from your destination, tossed alone in a tiny boat? Roz Savage, a one-time management consultant turned full-time rower, environmental advocate, and inspirational speaker completed a grueling 103-day, 2,935-mile (4,723-kilometer) oceanic ordeal in 2005. Storms broke all of her oars and claimed her stove, stereo, and cockpit navigation instruments. Her satellite phone failed with nearly four weeks left on the journey. Undaunted, Roz rowed on. In 2008, she rowed solo from San Francisco to Hawaii, as part one of a three-part journey to draw attention to environmental problems that threaten the ocean, and to encourage individual action. The British ocean rower and environmental campaigner has rowed over 11,000 miles, taken 3.5 million oarstrokes, and spent cumulatively nearly a year of her life at sea in a 23-foot rowboat. Her personal creed of taking life "one oarstroke at a time," and her promotion of the EcoHero movement, has inspired countless people around the world.

Mark Manders: Parallel Occurrences/ Documented Assignments; Through April 15, Hoffman Galleries

The first major North American exhibition of work by acclaimed Dutch artist Mark Manders features a body of new sculptures and works on paper created specifically for it. This nationally touring exhibition includes roughly fifteen new sculptural works and three loaned works, one of which is from The Pinnell Collection of Dallas.

Since 1986, Mark Manders has been engaged in what he calls his "Self-Portrait as a Building," an ongoing, monumental project that has come to define his overall practice. Language, as title, content, and formal structure, remains a key element of his process, in which objects are accumulated in a manner that replicates sentences.

As the artist explains, "This building can shrink or expand at any moment . . . all words created by mankind are on hand." In effect, Manders gives thoughts physical form; his hypothetical building becomes an evolving space through which he investigates the process of thinking.

The Trammell & Margaret Crow Collection of Asian Art

David Gibson: Toward Kasuga Shrine Along a Pathway of Lanterns; February 25-April 29

David Gibson describes his approach to the important Shinto-Buddhist shrine Kasuga Taisha in Nara as he first experienced it in 2005: "Kasuga Shrine is located at the far end of Nara Park. On the walk through Nara Park, one encounters a forest with inviting paths...The paths merge into an avenue that reveals the first glimpses of ancient stone lanterns; only a few at first, then more and more as one draws nearer to the shrine... Remnants of paper are attached to the stone lantern windows. These fragile papers, with prayers written in calligraphy, linger year-round from festivals when all 3,000 lanterns are illuminated by candles, keeping a centuries-old tradition alive. These visual and historic elements offer a transporting and a calming experience. Kasuga Grand Shrine is a place of refuge and contemplation."

Gibson's description introduces a series of photographs from which a selection has been made for this exhibition. Their sequence follows the order of pathway to the shrine, first built in the 8th century to house tutelary and ancestral deities of the powerful Fujiwara clan. The approach, shaded by a towering forest, induces a process of purification, important in all Shinto ritual. The mind dispels clutter and settles into peacefulness, from which awareness heightens.

MUSEUM HOURS: Tuesday-Sunday (10am-5pm); open Thursday until 9pm; closed Monday; admission is always free. A guided tour of the permanent collection is offered every Thursday at 6:30pm and begins in the lobby.
